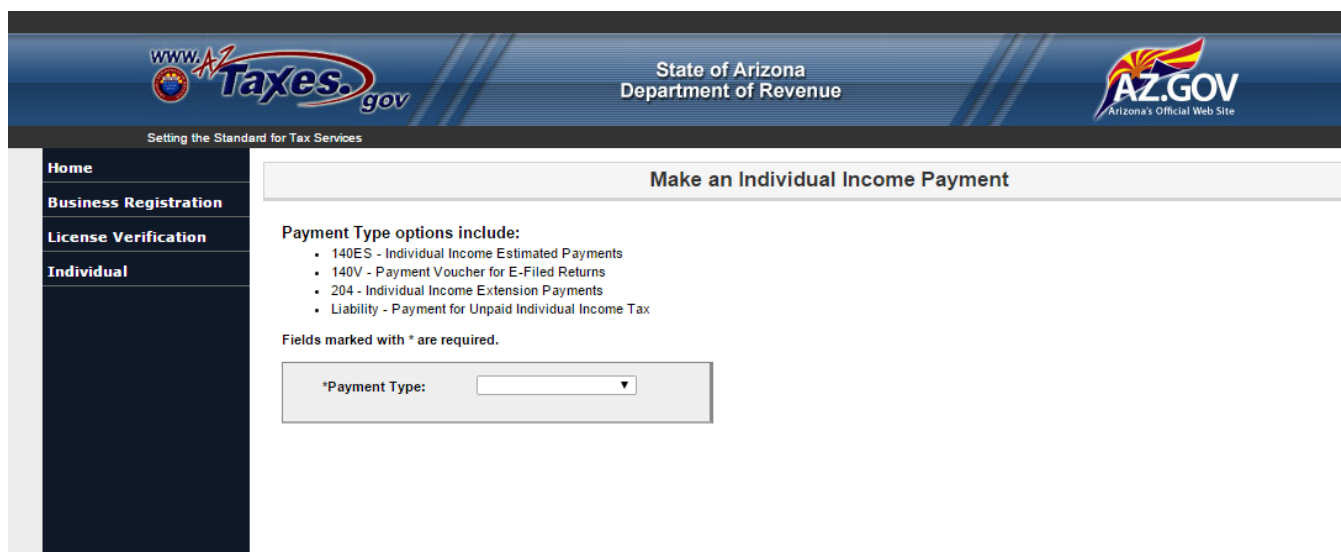

Individual Credit Card Payment

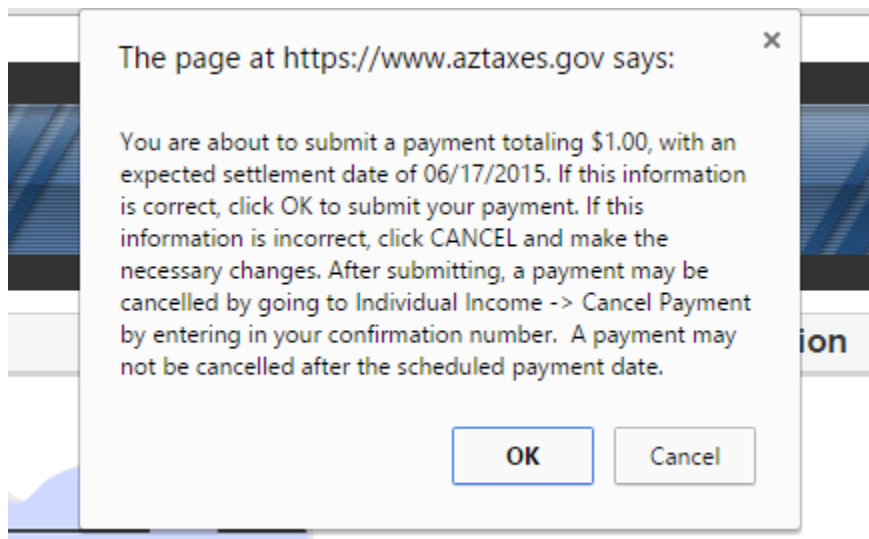
