To qualify for a Home Office deduction, the area must be a dedicated space that is regularly and <u>exclusively</u> used for the business activity.

SELF-EMPLOYED BUSINESS OWNER

To claim deductions for business use of your home when you are self-employed, the office space must be your <u>principal</u> place of business and you must be able to illustrate that business income is produced in the office. These considerations apply to self-employed individuals, because "employees" who work from home are not entitled to claim a Home Office deduction, even if the employer requires the employee to maintain an office in the home. The 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) eliminated an employee's ability to deduct unreimbursed, job-related expenses paid with personal funds as miscellaneous itemized deductions.
